INTRODUCTION

The following Tabulated Information on Old Closed-Out Landfills was compiled as a Special Projects assignment by the N.C. DEHNR, Division of Solid Waste Management, August, 1992. These Tables include documentation from the Solid Waste Landfill files and Super-Fund Files and Listings.

The Pertinent Details section of the tables includes; Closure dates, Order of Approval Dates, Date Operation began, and any reference to documentation that hazardous or Toxic Waste was Potentially Placed in the Landfill.

If the site has an EPA Reference Number, these reference files were reviewed and Summarized in the Pertinent Details Column with the most up-to-date Assessment or Site Investigation results. Specific Contamination is also summarized in this column.

15 of the 148 Closed-out landfills noted in the document are recommended for further Evaluation by the Super-Fund Section of the N.C. DEHNR. These 15 sites are relisted in tabular form at the back of this document for easy reference.

LANDFILL LISTING PERIOD & LIMITATIONS

This Listing of Closed-Out Landfills, was compiled by the N.C. DEHNR, Division of Solid Waste Management, August 1992. This Listing is limited to the Landfills operated and Closed during the Period of March, 1971 through August, 1992 (State regulated and permitted Landfills). This Landfill listing document primarily consists of converted landfills which have documentation of conversion on file at N.C. DEHNR in Raleigh. The remainder of the landfill list, includes the more recent permitted and non-permitted landfills placed in operation and Closed-Out since the conversion period, and a small number of dumps closed during the 1971-1974 regulatory assessment period.

In March of 1971, North Carolina enacted a statewide solid waste management program which required all landfills to operate under order of approval, according to an established set of rules governing solid waste management. 160 old dumps or disposal sites, were brought up to regulatory standards and Converted to Landfills during the 1971-1974 regulatory assessment period. However, this listing includes only 81 of those converted, due to limited availability of documentation at the office of the Division of Solid Waste Management in Raleigh, and due to the fact that many of these landfills have been expanded or for other reasons are not yet closed-out.

The dates that these sites were converted to approved solid waste disposal facilities are noted in the "Pertinent Details" column of the list. Approximately 319 of 479 dumps which were not converted, were closed during the period of 1971 through 1974. As noted above, a Small number of the 319 closed dumps which were called landfills and have EPA reference file numbers, are also included in this listing with a summary of referenced EPA Investigation results.

Some of the landfills in this listing document were expanded into adjacent areas or had other landfill modifications which allowed continued operations and therefore are not considered officially Closed-Out at this time although Closure documentation may exist for earlier phases of landfilling at these sites.
