Scrap Metal and Automotive Recycling

The purpose of this directory is to create awareness of and appreciation for scrap metal and automotive recycling industries in North Dakota. This directory will allow customers to find businesses that provide recycling services.

Other purposes include increasing cooperation among the companies listed in this directory, providing easier access to Department of Health regulatory programs, and promoting North Dakota recycling businesses and workers through cooperation with state and national recycling associations.

This directory includes North Dakota scrap metal processors and automotive recycling companies who agreed to be listed. (Some companies from Montana, Minnesota and South Dakota also are listed, since they are located in border communities or often do business in North Dakota.)

Directory Listings

1) Scrap metal processors: Listings include companies or individuals that process steel and other metals such as lead, copper, zinc, aluminum scrap, automotive batteries, animal hides and furs and steel appliances. These recyclers typically purchase materials and dismantle, sort, process, prepare and ship these items as raw materials. Some processes are simple and others are complicated. The purchase of aluminum cans often is termed "redemption."

2) Automotive recyclers and salvage operations: Listings include companies or individuals that process automobiles, automotive components, trucks or farm implements in such a manner that they sell used, rebuilt or remanufactured parts or components. Such businesses may include rebuilders of specialized vehicles or classic car restorers, as well as automotive wreckers with salvage operations.

3) Abandoned Automobile Program (AAP) licensees: This directory serves as the official listing of AAP license holders. One requirement of having a license is public release of application information. All bids for work with abandoned automobiles are automatically faxed or mailed to holders of this license, and are placed in certain newspapers in the state.

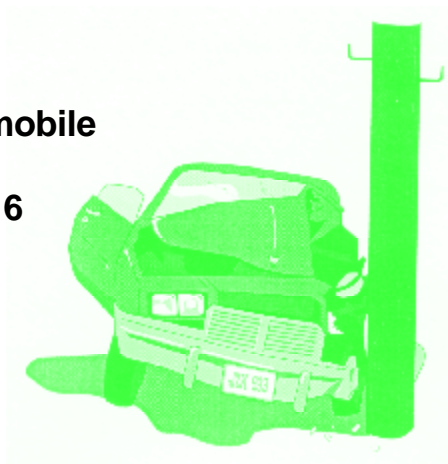
There is no fee for Abandoned Automobile Program licenses. In fact, a license application often may be approved over the telephone. Projects worth several hundreds of thousands of dollars are expected during the next five years.

4) This directory does not include Hides for Habitat recycling programs, brown goods recyclers, computer dismantlers and recyclers, or automotive towing companies.

About Recycling

Recycling scrap metals and automobiles saves energy, conserves natural resources and saves valuable landfill space.

Recycling means more than collecting aluminum cans. Other “R” words include rent, repair, restore, reuse and reduce. Sometimes these words are more important to the recycling efforts of our state than true recycling.

The scrap metal recycling industry is considered the largest type of recycler due to the weight of recycled material. Because there are no end markets for these materials in North Dakota, the processed recyclables are sold to markets in other states – a form of economic development.



Selling scrap metal products to out-of-state buyers is secondary economics and a good investment for our state. Selling parts, especially rebuilt or remanufactured parts, to out-of-state buyers is primary economics and a great investment for our state.

Scrap metal processors and automotive recycling businesses and individuals are economically and environmentally IMPORTANT to North Dakota!

The North Dakota Department of Health publically recognizes companies that protect our state’s beautiful environment. If you believe someone is doing a great job, let us know!

About Abandoned Automobiles

Abandoned automobiles are a health hazard and adversely affect our environment, our communities and the beautification efforts made by community governments. Sometimes an abandoned automobile starts a uncontrolled waste site, or an illegal dump. This means if a land owner or the community doesn't catch the "dumped car body," it acts as a magnet. The first litter attracts used oil, tires, appliances, mattresses and, worse, household garbage.

An Abandoned Automobile Program license allows a company to participate in county cleanups of abandoned automobiles. This license does not mean that a company with a license is inspected or regulated, but rather that it has registered with our office. Licenses can be revoked for failing to follow environmental and health regulations.

Abandoned automobiles, automotive components, other vehicles and scrap metals often are litter magnets. It is everyone's responsibility to prevent littering and illegal dumps.

Littering is a crime in North Dakota, enforceable by any law enforcement agency or states attorney. Depending upon the amount littered or dumped, the fine is \$500 or \$1,000. Help North Dakota stay clean – report illegal dumpers to local law enforcement.

Related Department Publications

The following publications may help scrap metal or automotive recyclers understand and comply with waste management regulations. These publications are updated often. If you have one, you should first ask, "Is this the most current copy?"

North Dakota Century Code (NDCC) is the state law; North Dakota Administrative Code (NDAC) is the state rules. The legislature writes the law, and the Department of Health promulgates the rules. These are based on federal laws and rules, specifically United States Code and the Code of Federal Regulations.

There are three easy ways to find copies of the NDCC and NDAC. (1) Each states attorney's office has a copy. (2) You can download the latest versions free-of-charge from the Department of Health website – www.health.state.nd.us. (3) Or, if you prefer, you can purchase official copies of the laws and rules from the Department of Health. All other publications are available free-of-charge by downloading from the website or contacting the department.

The department may publish a POLICY for specific issues. If the policy applies and you follow it, you are in compliance.
