Information About Lambert

- Lambert is the 11th busiest airport in North America for aircraft operations and 15th in total passengers.
- Lambert has a 5.1 billion annual economic impact on the St. Louis region.
- The airport sits on approximately 2,000 acres of land and with the “W1W” expansion and the addition of a 9000 foot runway well underway, will increase by about 75% by 2006.

Information About Lambert

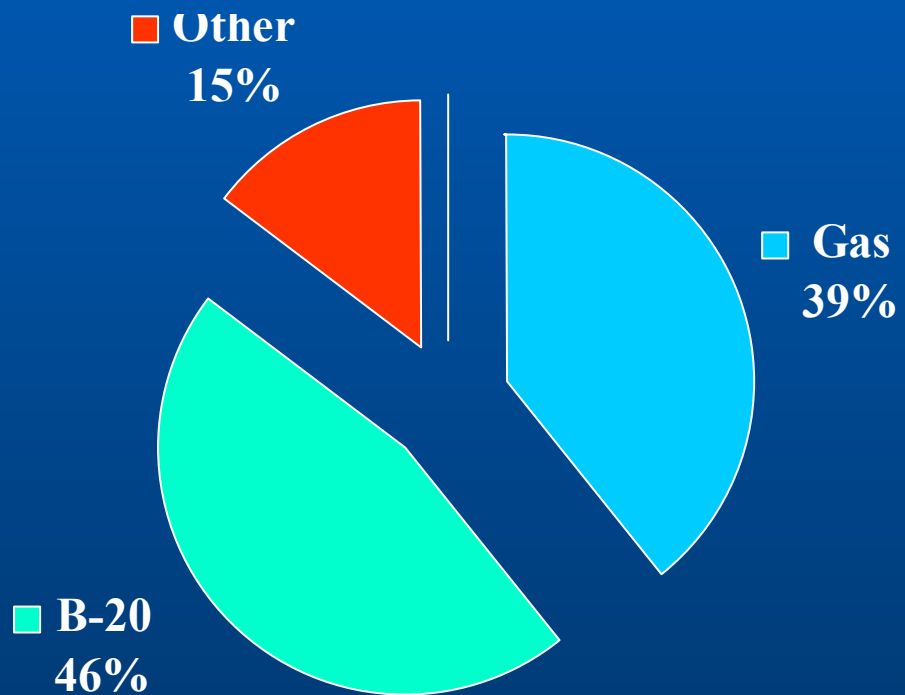
- Lambert has 87 gates serving 7 major, 11 commuter, 6 on-site air-cargo airlines, and 2 major charter companies on a regular basis.
- Lambert employs over 19,000 people through airlines, vendors, service companies, and the City of St. Louis.
- Of the 19,000, 688 are city employees.
- The airport is owned and operated by the City of St. Louis.

Description

There are 23 departments and over 600 pieces of equipment involved in airport ground operations and maintenance.

Biodiesel is the most widely used fuel in our fleet of rolling stock and it plays a crucial role in the reliability of our equipment as well as the health of our service personnel and the traveling public.

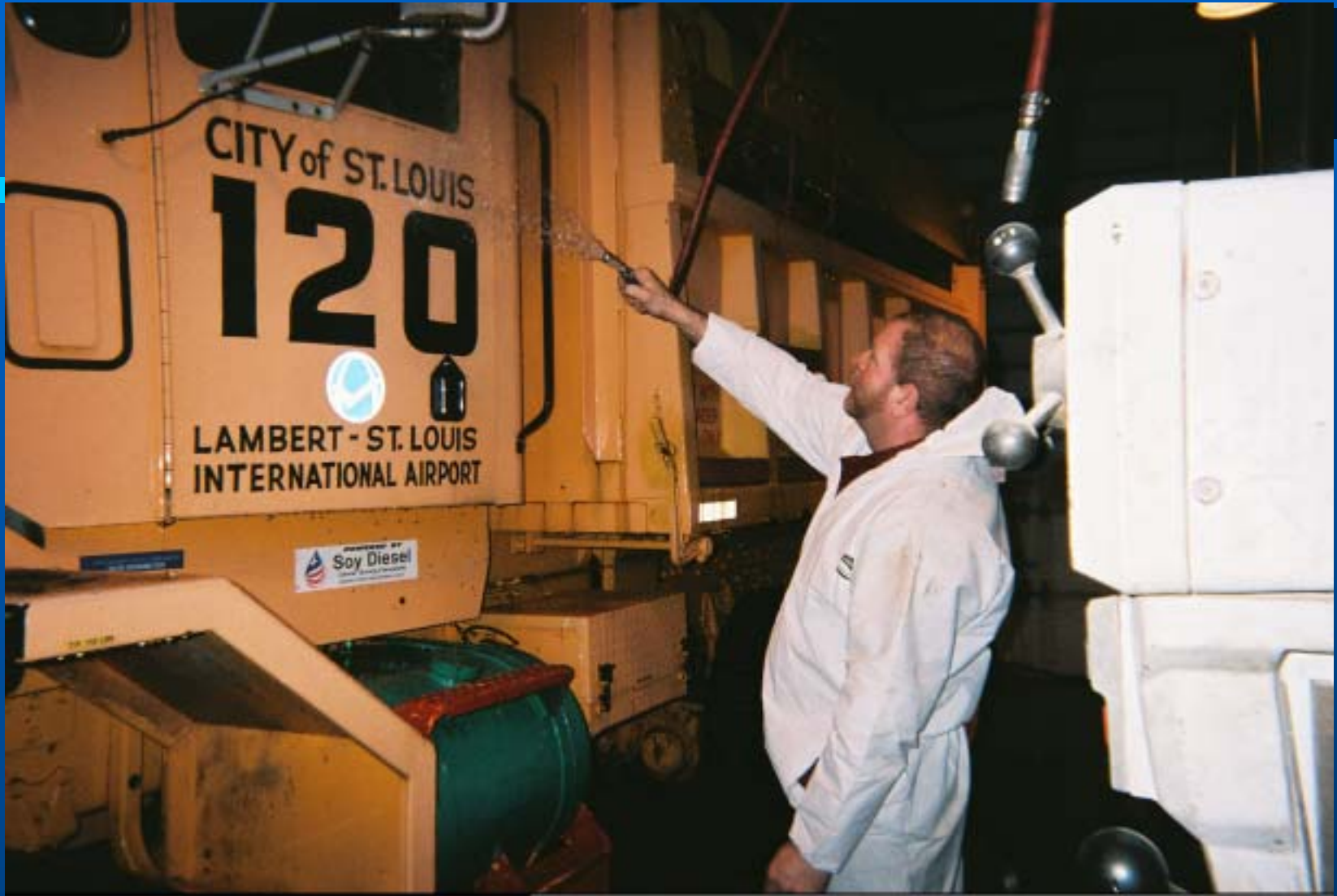
