Life Cycle Assessment / Life Cycle Management: A Bridge to a Sustainable Future Seattle, Washington – September 23-25, 2003

Decision-Making Perspectives:

A working session to analyze LCA's contribution to management, product and process design, and policy decision-making

This session will explore life cycle-based methods and tools in comparison with traditional methods and analytical tools applied from various user perspectives to a common product system. The experience, including presentations, group discussion, and collaborative analysis segments, is intended to provide a significant departure from the typical conference presentation followed by audience Q&A format.

Specifically, the role of LCA in management, product design, process development, and regulatory or policy development decisions will be analyzed for power trains

(engine/transmission/drive train) for personal vehicles. The analysis will provide the audience insights on the costs, benefits, and execution requirements associated with the application of LCA as an expert practitioner would view them during the initial scoping and goal definition stage of a project.

How will the session work?

Prior to the conference, perspective leaders have been provided with a short background document describing the system characteristics, the nature of the exercise, a tentative agenda for the session, and some suggestions on how the various perspective teams might proceed up to the conference. At the conference, brief presentations by perspective leaders will reveal:

- Steps in decision-making processes
- o Tools used in decision making (not including LCA tools and related software)
- Information needs
- Insights gained
